2016 Vermentino Carneros Estate - Our second release of this refreshing Italian varietal under the Fleur label. The fruit is sourced from both of Francis Mahoney's certified sustainable Carneros vineyards. This pale straw colored wine has glorious aromas of citrus and apple. On the palate, this wine shows off a bright, refreshing citrus profile with a most intriguing mineral note that sets it apart from all other white wines.

2016 Fleur Chardonnay North Coast - whole-cluster pressing, a cool fermentation, and limited time in neutral French oak barrels preserves the delicate flavors. Vivid citrus, peach, apple, and stone fruit aromas are accented with just a hint of sur-lies character. Clean fruit envelops the palate, while refreshing acidity lingers, creating a versatile and food friendly wine.

2016 Fleur Pinot Noir Rosé North Coast - This lovely wine packs a nose full of bright, fresh strawberries and honeysuckle. The fruit flavors are delicate, yet expansive across the palate. You can easily recognize the Pinot Noir statement that winemaker Ken Foster brings to this wine each vintage. A refreshing spring/summer staple.

2015 Fleur Pinot Noir Monterey - Sourced from vineyards that winemaker Ken Foster has worked with for many years, this Pinot has strawberry & raspberry aromas with a hint of exotic spice and a mouthful of ripe berries on the palate.

2014 Fleur Pinot Noir Carneros - First bottled in 1987, the Fleur Pinot Noir Carneros was the first Fleur release. Grown in our vineyards and those of our long time Carneros neighbors, today's Fleur Pinot is a bigger, richer wine but still perfectly balanced and approachable. This Pinot is packed with the cherry & strawberry aromas/flavors typically found in Carneros.
