2015 Vermentino Las Brisas Vineyard Carneros - Our first release of this refreshing Italian varietal under the Fleur label. The fruit is sourced from Francis Mahoney's Las Brisas Vineyard in the Sonoma portion of Carneros. This pale straw colored wine has glorious aromas of citrus and apple. On the palate, this wine shows off a bright, refreshing citrus profile with a most intriguing mineral note that sets it apart from all other white wines.

2013 Fleur Pinot Noir Carneros - First bottled in 1987, the Fleur Pinot Noir Carneros was the first Fleur release. This Pinot is packed with the cherry & strawberry aromas/flavors typically found in Carneros.
