## FLEUR PINOT NOIR ROSÉ

In 2016, the continuing drought and mild winter gave the vines a jump start on their production. Still, this early start was somewhat negated by the absence of prolonged high heat spells during the vines' growing period. In the end, the Pinot Noir for this Rosé was picked about a week and a half earlier than normal, and the fruit was in excellent condition.

Sporting its newly upgraded package design, the Fleur Pinot Rosé has very typical Pinot Noir floral and fruit aromas that set the stage for a mouthful of fresh strawberry, raspberry, and honeysuckle. Perfectly balanced with fresh fruit and bright acidity, this Rosé will leave you with a mouth-watering finish that is very refreshing and palate cleansing. Another stunner by winemaker Ken Foster.
